Lipu – BirdLife Italy, Lombard Regional Park of the Ticino Valley



In the Po plain, North west of Italy, near Milan

# **Description**

- Mixed broadleaved forest of pedunculated oak, poplars, European hornbeam, alders, elderberry, elms, willows, maples, ash (hygrophilous, mesophilous, xerophilous woods)
- Intensively urbanised area (about 20 million people live in the Po plain)
- Close to Milan Malpensa airport



- Key freshwater ecological corridor between Alps and Apennines
- The largest remaining fragments of forest in the Poplain
- Includes virtually all the biodiversity occurring in the Po plain
- more than 3250 animal species and 1000 plant species

#### **Protection status & conservation actions**

- Two regional parks (Lombardy, Piedmont).
- Nature park
- Man & Biosphere Reserve Ticino Valgrande Verbano
- 16 Natura 2000 sites



### **Threats**

- Urbanisation/Infrastructures
- Alien species
- Air pollution
- Soil conversion
